

2022 MMOGTA Division 2 Rules

Classes: 3750, 4250, 4750, 5000 4.0 MPH, 5250, 5750, 6250

1. 3.5 MPH speed limit with the exception of the 5000lb 4.0 MPH. There will be a 100-foot speed limit cone. Any tractor blowing the horn after that cone will be disqualified.
2. 15.5x38 maximum tire size. Any rim width may be used. No full cut tires allowed. No restrictions on the tops of lugs. Fronts of lugs and casings between lugs cannot be altered.
3. Tractors may pull in any gear. NO shifting of TA's allowed "On the Go" while pull is in motion.
4. No alterations that may change the appearance from original except wheels, weights, seat and safety equipment. No removing of front tire or wheel to make weight. Additional Fuel Tank May Be Added, Battery May Be Relocated.
5. Any agricultural updraft carburetor allowed. Number of barrels, throats, venturi, must be same as the stock carburetor for the make and model of tractor (JD can use Duplex carb).
6. Tractors may run up to 10% over stock RPM's (See the MMOGTA no load M&W RPM chart)
7. Hitch no higher than 18 inches and no closer than 18 inches from center of rear axle to hitching point. Hitch/drawbar must be rigid in all direction. Hitch material must be a minimum of ¾ inch thick and have 3/4-inch material around the hole. Opening for hook must be at least 3.5 inches in diameter or a 3-inch x 3.5-inch hole may be used. (Hook must swing freely). No twisted or vertical clevises. If turnbuckles are used, they must be category one and use a ¾ inch bolt for mounting.
8. Wheelie bars are mandatory. They must be independent of hitch, at least 4 inches behind the tires, no higher than 10 inches off the ground, no closer than 20 inches together, have 5-inch x 5inch or larger pads, and must support the weight of the tractor in its heaviest class.
9. All tractors must have a working breakaway kill switch, fenders, and wheelie bars.
10. No speedometers or speed detection can be used, if tractor is equipped speedometer, it cannot be used.
11. All rules, unforeseen problems or oversights will be ruled on by the tech committee and the chairman of the class, with their decision being final. Rules are subject to discussion at the end of every year with exception to safety, oversights and unforeseen concerns that can be changed at any point.
